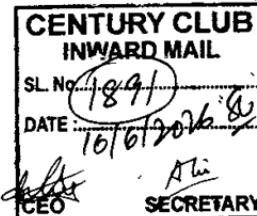

Subject: Notice intimating the interim order dated 04.06.2026 passed in original suit bearing O.S No. 3797/2026 filed by S. Upendra & Co., pending on the file of the Court of the Hon'ble XIX Addl. City Civil and Sessions Judge, Bangalore (CCH-18).

We write to you on behalf of our client, S. Upendra & Co., having office at: No. 1017, Ground Floor, 10th Main, 1st Block, 3rd Stage, Basaveshwaranagar Bangalore - 560 079, the Plaintiff in the aforementioned matter. The above suit has been filed by our Client under Order VII Rule 1 read with Section 26 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, against you *inter alia* seeking the following reliefs:

- a. Granting Permanent Injunction restraining the Defendants, their henchmen, their representatives, their agents, servants or any persons claiming through or under them either jointly or severally, from publishing and/or circulating the Impugned Report or write

comments, statements or allegations, whatsoever, that is defaming the Plaintiff or any person related to the Plaintiffs.

- b. Granting Permanent Injunction restraining the Defendants, their henchmen, their representatives, their agents, servants or any persons claiming through or under them either jointly or severally, from deliberating or discussing the Impugned Report that is defaming the Plaintiff or any person related to the Plaintiffs
- c. Granting Mandatory Injunction directing the Defendant No. 2, their henchmen, their representatives, their agents, servants or any persons claiming through or under them either jointly or severally, to unconditionally withdraw all comments made in the Impugned Report against the Plaintiff herein.
- d. Grant costs of litigations
- e. Pass such other orders or directions as this Hon'ble Court deems fit in the interest of justice and equity

Along with the Plaint, our Client has filed the following Interlocutory Application:

- a. an Interlocutory Application (I.A. No.1/2026) under Order XXXIX, Rule 1 and 2 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 praying for *ad-interim ex-parte* order of injunction, thereby restraining the Defendants or, their agents, servants, henchmen, representatives or any other person acting on their behalf in any way from publishing the Special Audit Committee Final Report on Capital Projects and Governance Protocols 2024-2026 Report dated 09.05.2026, during the pendency of the present suit, in the interests of justice and equity.
- b. an Interlocutory Application (I.A. No.2/2026) under Order XXXIX, Rule 1 and 2 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 seeking an *ad-interim ex-parte* order of stay on Special Audit Committee Final Report on Capital Projects and Governance Protocols 2024-2026 Report dated 09.05.2026, during the pendency of the present suit, in the interests of justice and equity;



1. The I.A No. 1/2026 and I.A No. 2/2026 was taken up for hearing by the Hon'ble Court on 03.06.2026 and vide Order dated 04.06.2026, the Hon'ble Court was pleased to grant *ex-parte ad-interim* order as under:

"Issue ad-interim ex-parte temporary injunction order against defendants restraining them, their agents, servants, henchmen, representatives or any other person acting on their behalf in any way from publishing the Special Audit Committee Final Report on Capital Projects and Governance Protocols 2024-2026 Report dated 09-05-2026 and also Special Audit Committee Final Report on Capital Projects and Governance Protocols 2024-2026 Report dated 09-05-2026 is stayed till next date. In view of the above said order, plaintiff shall comply the provision of Order XXXIX Rule 3(a) of C.P.C. Further, the plaintiff shall pay the requisite process fee and furnish sufficient copies within stipulated period. If the plaintiff fails to comply the above said order, in such circumstances, the above said ex-parte order stands automatically cancelled. Office is directed to issue certified copy of the ex-parte order only after compliance of above said order by the plaintiff. Issue notice of I.A.No.1 & 2 to the defendants along with suit summons. Returnable by 02.07.2026"

Furthermore, kindly note that the Hon'ble Court has now posted the matter on 02.07.2026

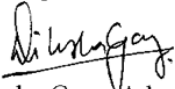

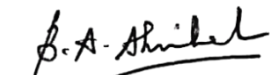
